

Exactly One Week Until the Draw for Position!

Please plan your travels conservatively so that you can comfortably make the required draw on Wednesday evening.

Rondy Week Schedule:

Wednesday, Feb 26:

Draw for position (5 PM doors open for sign-up, 6:30 PM Draw)
Hard Rock Café. **Required for all drivers.**

Tozier Track closes for grooming and will re-open Sunday afternoon

Thursday, Feb 27:

Rookie Driver's Meeting (8:30 AM) ASDRA Clubhouse. **Required for all drivers who have not run the Rondy Open World Championship.**

Musher's Breakfast (9:30 - 10:30 AM) ASDRA Clubhouse

Rondy Driver's Meeting (10:30 AM) ASDRA Clubhouse. **Required for all drivers.** One handler is welcome but not required.

Trail Go-Around (12 Noon) Meet in Tozier Track Staging Area with sled.
Drivers only.

Meet the Mushers (1 - 3 PM) Tozier Track Staging Area. Open to the community, including school groups.

Friday, Saturday, Sunday:

Report to 4th Avenue (10 AM)

Driver's Meeting (11 AM) at 4th and E

Race Start (12 Noon) at 4th and D (12:15 Delayed Start on Saturday)

Sunday: Banquet at La Cabana (4th and Cordova)

Important Updates:

1. **Please let us know if your plans have changed.** We publish the musher's guide under a tight timeline and prefer it to accurately reflect the field. Contact me if you signed up on-line but do not intend to run the 2020 Rondy.
2. "K-9 Crews" are invited to the draw on Wednesday evening and you will see them again during the race weekend. Please be welcoming and congenial.

3. Mike Ford from the radio station will be at the Wednesday night draw, at the Tozier Track on Thursday morning and afternoon, and will be interested in getting interviews to insert in the radio program over the weekend.
Remember - you have about 30 seconds to make an impression!

Finally, please go through all of your equipment keeping in mind the unique demands of this race. Your sled bag must fully function to contain a dog or two. Check your snaps, your zippers, and create redundant systems for yourself.
