

Alaskan Sled Dog & Racing Association
Tozier Track Protocol
2020

All users of the Tozier Track are expected to comply with the following:

- Handle all dogs in a humane manner. ASDRA will not tolerate ANY physical abuse or inhumane treatment of animals.
- Abide by ALL Municipality of Anchorage animal ordinances.
- All dogs must be current on and owner must have proof of current rabies vaccinations as required by State and Municipal laws.
- ASDRA strongly encourages that all dogs be immunized and current against the core recommendation of AVMA (parvovirus and distemper)- ASDRA also strongly recommends participating dogs be current on respiratory vaccines available.
- Do NOT run any dog(s) that show physical signs of injury.
- Do keep dogs with infectious/contagious diseases away from Tozier Track (i.e. Parvovirus, Distemper, Kennel Cough, etc.)
- No overnight camping at Tozier track is allowed without the prior approval of the ASDRA Board or their official representative.
- The groomed dog trails are designated for sleds and sled dogs not biking or skiing.

All track users agree to:

- Maintain the holding area in a sanitary condition including the removal of all fecal matter. A dumpster is provided for your convenience.
- Keep all dogs restrained to the their vehicle area and do not allow them to interact with other people or animals not in their group.
- Maintain the premises and dogs in such a manner that they do not constitute a nuisance to owners and occupiers of neighboring property.
- Use sled brakes to stop, not to control team speed. Attaching drags of any type behind sleds that damage the trail surface is prohibited.
- Follow trail courtesy whenever passing.
- Posts are meant to restrain sleds during team hook ups only. Do not attach chain or cable to poles from vehicles.
- NO dogs are to be left unattended outside the vehicle at Tozier Track.

Complaints against track users are to be submitted to the ASDRA Board within 24 hours of alleged violation. Include the following information:

Your name, address and telephone number. (as the filer)

Violator's name, vehicle license number and general description.

Alleged violation (be specific) and include date and time of incident.

Note additional witness's names and telephone numbers.

ANY VIOLATOR IS SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY ASDRA BOARD MEMBERS. FAILURE TO COMPLY COULD RESULT IN LOSS OF TRACK PRIVILEGES.
